Multicultural Community Service: Full Tuition on the basis of leadership in the multicultural community. Requires top 50% class rank or ACT of 20, or SAT of 950. Needs two letters of recommendation.

NU Paths Program: Full Tuition or more at UNK - Offered to promising minority students who wish to enter UNMC health professional programs. Includes guaranteed admission to UNMC after UNK work is done.

Omaha World Herald/Kearney Hub Honors Scholarship: Full ride - ACT of 28, top 10% of class, show significant leadership in co-curricular activities, an essay, and two letters of recommendation.

- **Davis:** Up to full cost of attendance, depending on need - Offered to academically talented racial minority students. Apply for admissions by January 15th. Deadline: February 1st
- **Eastman Mathematics:** \$4,000 (renewable) - Need to apply to UNL and be enrolled in College of Arts and Science with a major in mathematics (Engineering students are not eligible). Requires a letter of application to scholarship committee, transcripts with ACT scores, and two letters of recommendation.
- **Freshman Scholarships:** Various scholarships for new students including Regents, David Memorial, specific colleges and academic department scholarships. Take ACT by December and apply for admission. Deadline: January 15th
- **Gupta:** Room and board - minority students studying engineering or the physical sciences. Deadline: January 15th
- **Honors Program:** Full cost for textbooks for four years. Deadline: Nov 15th (early decision) or March 1st
- **J.D. Edwards Honors:** Full tuition, room, board, books, and fees, renewable. Program is in Computer Science and Management and requires ACT 31 or SAT 1380, GPA of 4.8/5.0, and top 10% of class. - **Larson:** Varies - For minority students who show outstanding academic and leadership ability. Deadline: January 15th
- **Native American Heritage:** Up to full cost of attendance - Offered based on need to students with tribal affiliation. Deadline: February 1st
- **Nebraska Achievement:** \$1,000 up to full tuition (renewable) diversity scholarship. Deadline: January 15th
- **NU Paths Program:** Full Tuition or more at UNL - Offered to promising minority students who wish to enter UNMC health professional programs. Includes guaranteed admission to

- **College of Business Administration:** Varies - For Students planning to attend UNO College of Business Administration. Selection based on: ACT, class rank, leadership potential, school and community activities, financial need, and teacher recommendations. Deadline: February 1st
- **College of Education:** Various amounts for students planning to major in education. Priority Deadline: April 1st
- **Davis:** Up to full cost of attendance, depending on need - Offered to academically talented racial minority students. Apply for admissions by January 15th. Deadline: February 1, 2009
- **Distinguished Scholar Competition:** Top 15% of class, ACT composite of 26 or SAT of 1250, and UNO application. Finalists will participate in a scholarship competition exam. Deadline: February 1st
- **Freshman Scholarships:** Various scholarships available to new students, including the Regents and Chancellor's Scholarship programs. Take ACT by December and apply for admission by Feb 1st. File a FAFSA form by March 1st. Most freshmen will not need an actual scholarship application to be considered. A scholarship supplement is due by January 15th **only** if you are related to a UNO or Omaha Police Dept. employee or you have a physical/medical disability. See www.ses.unomaha.edu for details.
- **Goodrich Scholarship Program:** Amount varies. For students with extreme financial need. Need 2 letters of recommendation, ACT scores. FAFSA form due by March 1st. Deadline: February 15th
- **Honors Program:** ACT of 26 - no specific award, but some departments do offer non-renewable tuition waivers.
- **Isaacson Incentive:** \$1,000 renewable - Requires 4.0/5.0 GPA, ACT of 20 or SAT of 950, an essay, and two letters of recommendation. Deadline: January 15th
- **Music Department:** Varies from \$600 to \$4,800 (renewable) - Requires an application with two letters of recommendation. Call 554-3446 or see <http://music.UNOmaha.edu> for audition dates (November - March). Deadline: March 1st
- **Phillip Schragar Scholarship:** \$2,500 (renewable once) Considers primarily leadership ability along with academic achievement. Requires leadership involvement at UNO. Deadline: February 1st
- **STEP Scholarship:** Amount varies. Available to under-represented or non-traditional students who want to major in Science, Technology, Engineering, or Math. Requires ACT scores, financial need, and two letters of recommendation. A College Funding Estimator form will be required and the FAFSA form is due by March 1st. Deadline: February 15th

Award: \$5,000 renewable Deadline: March 1st

Criteria: Nebraska (non-resident) students must apply for admission to UNC. The award is almost automatic and is based on GPA and ACT/SAT test scores. They also offer other scholarships through a separate UNC Universal Scholarship Application submitted online in addition to your application for admission. American Legion Auxiliary (ALA) Scholarships: A student may submit only one application for only one of the Department (state) Scholarships. A student may submit only one application for only one of the National Scholarships. A student who wins a National Scholarship will not be eligible for a state award. Students must be veteran connected (daughter, son, grand-daughter, grand-son, step-son, step-daughter of veterans (SEE Mr. Braman for the applications and additional information)
